



About the Program

The E-Rate program provides K-12 schools and libraries with discounts for eligible services and products such as Internet access, telecommunications, basic network security, and certain types of network infrastructure.

E-Rate discounts range from 20% to 90% for eligible solutions, depending on economic need and location (urban or rural). There are approximately \$2.25 billion in disbursements available annually for to E-Rate applicants.

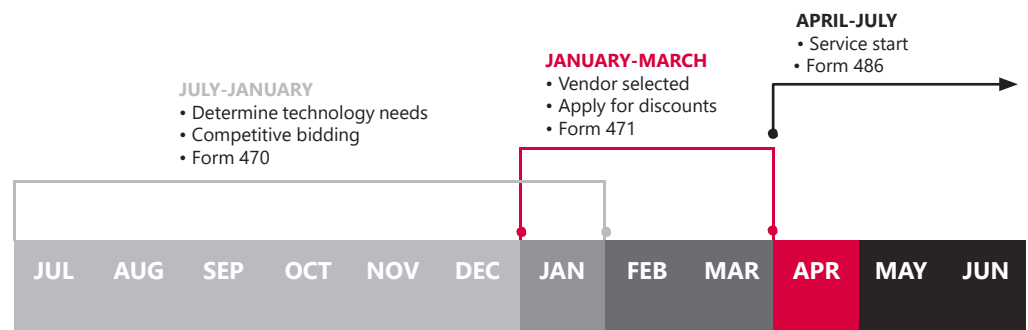
The Modern Classroom

The ongoing proliferation of innovative digital learning technologies and the need to connect students and teachers to life-long learning and information have led to a steady rise in demand for bandwidth in schools and libraries.

The modern classroom challenges the budget and infrastructure for many schools. Combat such challenges by leveraging the E-Rate program to offset costs of telecommunications products and services, internet access, internal connections, and basic maintenance of internal connections.

E-Rate Program: Key Changes

Be sure to utilize all 2020 funds your school may have received as funds are “use it or lose it” due to 2020 being designated as the transition year to bridge the old budget cycle to the new cycle beginning in 2021, when the new E-Rate funding formulas take effect.
